LOCAL INFORMATION LETTER

Brockwell Live is a collective of independent festivals that take place in Brockwell Park.

Covering a broad range of music genres and cultures, the festivals include **Brockwell Bounce**, a free family festival for the community of Lambeth on 31st May 2023. Additionally for 2023, the long-running community event, **Lambeth Country Show** will follow immediately after with its new dates of 10th and 11th June, sharing the site and minimising occupancy of the park.

This letter will give you key information about the events to be held in Brockwell Park. Outlined are the steps we are taking to minimise the event's impact on local residents, and how to get in touch with us during the event period.

BUILD & BREAK PERIOD

The build of the events will commence on the 15th May, with the dismantling phase scheduled to be complete by 18th June 2023.

In the interests of public safety, during this period certain park pathways will be closed to facilitate critical build activity and maintain safe working areas during the key construction phase. The event organisers, in partnership with London Borough of Lambeth, aim to ensure key paths that cross the event site remain open for as long as possible within the realms of safety, in order to minimise disruption and inconvenience to regular users of the park.

Pathway diversions will be displayed on signage within the park. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause and thank you in advance for your understanding.

Once the event period is complete on June 18th, no further major commercial events will take place in Brockwell Park in 2023. All public spaces will be cleaned and returned to the best possible standard by the event organisers and any ground repairs will be led by London Borough of Lambeth. All cleanup and reinstatement costs will be funded by the event organisers.

BROCKWELL HALL WORKS

London Borough of Lambeth will be commencing redevelopment works on Brockwell Hall in May 2023. The event organisers are working closely with the teams to manage both projects safely and with minimal inconvenience to the local community.

NOISE MANAGEMENT

To ensure we best minimise noise disruption to residents and businesses, we are required to carry out noise propagation tests on each of the event stages the day prior to the first festival. This will take place on Thursday 25th May 15:00–17:00. During this period, stage sound systems will be individually tested for up to five minutes at any one time to ensure systems are set to appropriate levels in line with Lambeth Council's guidelines.

On event days, sound checks are required ahead of opening the event to allow artists to prepare for their performance and to set appropriate artist specific noise levels.

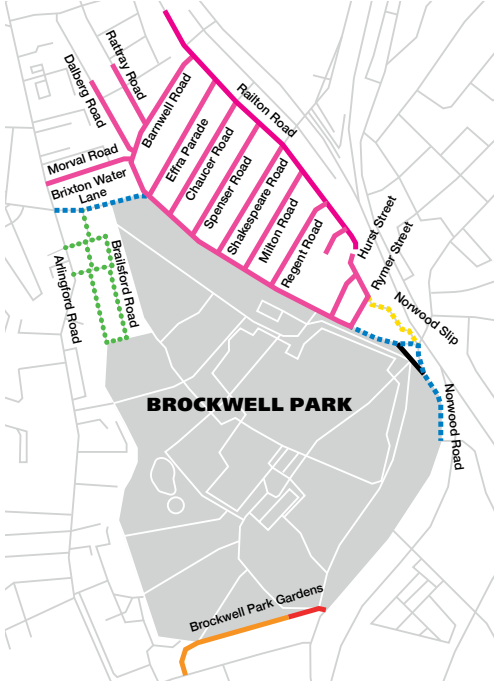
These will take place from the time noted in the table, for no more than 90 minutes each day.

We appreciate your understanding during these periods. If you have any concerns regarding noise levels during any of the live events, please contact us via the contact details overleaf, where we will be able to arrange attendance of our noise management team to investigate and advise.

TRAFFIC

Temporary road closures will be in place on event days to enable the safe and controlled movement of pedestrians towards public transport hubs; Brixton and Herne Hill Train Stations, ensure public safety and minimise disruption to local residents and businesses.

The following road closures will be implemented in accordance with the **KEY**.



KEY

BLACK ROADS CLOSED Intermittent Closure to support Build & Break Activity 15 May – 18 June 08:00–20:00.

Excluding event days where a full closure will be in place 26–29 May, 3–4 and 10–11 June 11:00–00:00

YELLOW ROADS CLOSED for all Event Days (Resident Access Only) 26–29 May, 3–4 and 10–11 June 11:00–00:00

GREEN ROADS CLOSED for all Event Days, excluding Lambeth Country Show (Resident Access Only) 26–29 May, 3–4 June 11:00–00:00

BLUE ROADS CLOSED during Event Day egress periods, excluding Lambeth Country Show 26–29 May, 3–4 June 20:30–23:30

RED ROAD CLOSED during Lambeth Country Show period only 8–9 June 08:00–20:00 and 10–11 June 06:00–22:00

PINK ROADS RESIDENT ACCESS ONLY during Event Day egress periods, excluding Lambeth Country Show. 26–29 May, 3–4 June 20:30–23:30 All pink roads must be accessed via Morval Road/Effra Road junction during this period.

ORANGE ROAD RESIDENT ACCESS ONLY during Lambeth Country Show period only 8–9 June 08:00–20:00 10–11, June 06:00–22:00 Access via Brockwell Park Gardens/Trinity Road junction during this period.

In addition to the road closures, there will also be parking suspensions in place to support event activity on Brixton Water Lane and Milkwood Road on event days. All closures and diversions will be clearly signposted and the traffic team will be positioned to assist residents to find their way.

Please note that Buses will continue to operate as normal through these road closures.

DELIVERIES

Where possible, please seek to arrange deliveries outside of the road closure times. The traffic management team will do their best to facilitate delivery access, but it cannot be guaranteed.

If you have a concern about an important delivery for your business or home, please contact the community team using the contact details overleaf.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

A normal service will run from Brixton Underground and Herne Hill Station throughout the event period. There will be managed entry to Herne Hill Station during each event day egress period, 21:30 – 23:30. Buses will continue to operate as normal throughout the event period.

SAFETY

The event organisers are working with Lambeth Council to ensure the events are delivered to the highest standard. During the event, the organisers will work closely with the Metropolitan Police and other statutory bodies, meeting regularly to respond quickly and effectively to issues raised by residents.

The safety and egress plans have been developed to manage the impact on the surrounding area and include waste removal and street cleaning, temporary toilets and security personnel positioned at key locations along the exit routes for the audience.

OFF THE FENCE X WINDRUSH 75

Off The Fence is a collaboration between The Brixton Project and Brockwell Live.

The Brixton Project have worked with local schools, artists, community groups and cultural organisations to curate a collage of multimedia artwork which recognises 75 years of Windrush and will be displayed along 400m of the festival perimeter fence from the 23rd May and throughout June 2023.
